The United States Capitol Police (“USCP”), Office of the General Counsel, is in receipt of your Request for Information (“RFI”). Your RFI seeks “identifiable records related to threat assessments and investigations involving U.S. Representative Nick Langworthy's Jamestown District Office in January 2026”.

The USCP denies your RFI for the following reasons:

- The information requested is not an “*identifiable record*” for the purposes of the USCP’s Public Request for Information Policy.
- The requested information could reasonably disclose techniques, guidelines, and/or procedures for law enforcement investigations or prosecutions.

Any requestor whose request is denied in whole or in part may administratively appeal the denial within seven (7) days after the date of the denial by submitting a letter via U.S. Mail to the Assistant Chief of Police for Standards and Training Operations, Re: Request for Information Appeal, 119 D Street, NE, Washington, D.C. 20510. All appeal decisions by the Department are final.
